Founded in 2016 in Philadelphia, Indie Go Inspire initially carved its niche by orchestrating music production events spotlighting independent artists and musicians throughout the city. This endeavor blossomed in 2018 with the launch of the first Indie Music Conference, aimed at demystifying the music industry for aspiring talents. The conference featured experts in radio, marketing, copywriting,

ing invaluable insights. In 2019, Patrice DeLisser steered Indie Go Inspire towards a global presence. The launch of the streetwear line "One Voice. One Sound." was not just a fashion statement but a resonant response to social injustice against people of color. "We have more in common than we do differences," Patrice asserts. "Music is a universal thread, binding diverse cultures. Whether in a remote hut or a Midtown Manhattan high-rise, music is integral to all cultures. The One Voice. 



Yet, they manage to emerge unharmed by relying on a combination of luck, quick thinking, smarts, and... light-sabers. 
